

BOOK 2 - LESSON 21

1 Sb.w. (v) F (k) = ck

In a one syllable base word, after a short vowel , the final (k) sound is spelled

digraph **ck** as in **sack, truck**

BOOK 2 – LESSON 22

1 Sb.w. M (e) = ee

In a one syllable base word, **the medial long (e) sound is spelled ee** as in **feet, and peep.**

BOOK 2 – LESSON 23

(j) a, o, u = j

The (j) sound is spelled with a **j** before an **a, o, or u** as in **jam & jar**

LESSON 23 CONT.

l (ch) = ch

The initial (ch) sound is spelled **ch** as in **chin**

(C) F (ch) = ch

After a consonant sound, the final (ch) sound is spelled digraph **ch** as in **lunch**

BOOK 2 – LESSON 24

1 S b.w. (v) F (ch) = tch

In a one syllable base word, after a short vowel sound the final (ch) sound is spelled **tch** and in **patch**

BOOK 2 - LESSON 25

1 S b.w. (v) F (f), (l), (s) = ff, ll, ss

In a one syllable base word, after a short vowel sound the final (f), (l), or (s) sound is spelled **ff, ll, or ss** as in **huff, mill, bass**

FLOSS RULE

BOOK 2 – LESSON 26

(oo) = oo

The short (oo) sound is spelled **oo** as in **book.**

The long (oo) sound is spelled **oo** as in **moon or groom.**

LESSON 26 CONT.

(vv) F (k) = k

After a vowel digraph, the final (k) sound is spelled with a **k** like **brook**

(vv) F (ch) = ch

After a vowel digraph, the final (ch) sound is spelled **ch** like **pooch**

BOOK 2 LESSON 27

(sh) = sh

The (sh) sound is spelled **sh** as in **ship.**

BOOK 2 – LESSON 29

b.w. + (e) (d) = -ed

A base word ending with a **t** or a **d** and suffix **-ed** is pronounced **(ed)** as in **planted.**
