

BOOK2 – LESSON 30

b.w. + (t) = **-ed**

A b. w. **ending in an unvoiced** sound is spelled suffix **-ed** and has a **(t)** sound as in **jumped**.

b.w.= (d) = **-ed**

A b. w. **ending in a voiced sound** is spelled suffix **-ed** and has a **(d)** sound as in **filled**.

BOOK 2 - LESSON 31

(i)(C) = © – e

A long (i) sound before a consonant sound is spelled © **consonant e** as in **five**.

(a)(C) = a-e

The long (a) sound before a consonant sound is spelled **a consonant e** as in **cake**

BOOK 2 - LESSON 32

(o)(C) = o – e

A long (o) sound before a consonant sound is spelled **o consonant e** as in **rope**.

(u)(C) = u-e

The long (u) sound before a consonant sound is spelled **u consonant e** as in **mule**.

BOOK 2 – LESSON 33

(V) (C) / (C) (V) =VCCV

The short vowel sound before two consonants and another short vowel sound is spelled **vowel-consonant-consonant-vowel** as in **contact**

BOOK 3 – LESSON 36

(h)(w) =wh

These two sound make and **unexpected sound** together and are spelled wh and are called **combination wh**

BOOK 3 – LESSON 37

[(C) (l)] = [Cle

A consonant sound plus the (l) sound at the end of a word is a **final stable syllable** and is spelled consonant-l-e.....code with a bracket.

BOOK 3 – LESSON 41

(e) (r) = er

The **(er)** sound is spelled **er**.

Combination **er** make and unexpected sound.

BOOK 3 – LESSON 42

2+Sb.w. M (e) = e-e

In a 2 or more syllable base word, the medial long (e) sound is spelled **e, consonant, e**

BOOK 3- LESSON 43

F (a) = ay

The final long (a) sound is spelled **ay**.

BOOK 3 – LESSON 45

(a)(r) = ar

The (ar) sound is spelled ar.
