The (or) sound is spelled **or**.

(k) (w) = qu

The (k) (w) sound is spelled **qu**

(k) (s) = x

The (k) (s) sound is spelled **x**.

BOOK 3 - LESSON 51

I, M, (au) = au

The initial and medial (au) sound is spelled **au**

F (au) is spelled aw

BOOK 3 – LESSON 52

F (i) = y The final long (i) is spelled **y**

F(i) = y The final short (i) is spelled **y**

(k) e, i, y, =k

The (k) sound before an **e, i, or y** is spelled with a **k**

BOOK 3 – LESSON 53

1S b.w. (V) (C)(C) =VCC in some words

In a 2 syllable B.W., a long vowel sound before 2 consonant sounds are spelled **vowel, consonant, consonant**

BOOK 4 – LESSON 56

I, M, (o) (i) =oi

The initial and medial (oi) is spelled **oi**

F (o) (i) = oy

The final (oi) sound is spelled **oy**

BOOK 4 – LESSON 57

I, M, (o) (u) = ou

The initial and medial (ou) sound is spelled **oi** as in **coin**

F (o) (u) = ow

The final (ou) sound is spelled **ow** as in **snow**

BOOK 4 – LESSON 58

I, M, (au) (l) = al

The initial and medial (au) (l) sound is spelled **al** as in **ball**

BOOK 4- LESSON 61

2S b.w. (v) F (k) = c

In a 2 syllable b.w. after a short vowel sound, the final (k) sound is spelled **c** as in picnic

BOOK 4 – LESSON 62

(j) e, l, y = g

The (j) sound before **e, l, y** is spelled with a **g** as in gem
